### Lacrosse

**Sacred Heart** (Panther Hollow Field - 102 Boundary St, Pittsburgh, PA 15207)

**Saturday May 25<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade 9:00 am**

Take I-279 South towards Pittsburgh. Take exit 2-A to get onto I-579 South toward the Veterans Bridge. Take right exit toward I-376 East. Stay on I-376 toward Monroeville. Continue onto the Boulevard of the Allies. Turn right onto Bates St. Turn left onto Second Ave. Second Ave turns slightly left and becomes Greenfield Ave. Turn left onto Saline St. Go two blocks (past Big Jim's) and make a left onto Boundary St. Go straight back under the railroad overpass and enter Panther Hollow. The field is beyond the parking area. It is also known as Junction Hollow Field.

**East Catholic** (Wilkins Primary School – 362 Churchill Rd Wilkins, PA 15235)

**Saturday May 25<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> grade 11:00 am**

**Eastbound, from Pittsburgh, on I-376 (Parkway East)**

Exit the Parkway East at the Churchill Exit. At the end of the exit ramp turn left onto Churchill Road. Stay on Churchill Road for about 1 1/2 miles; go past Edgewood Country Club, until you see Wilkins Elementary School on the left. Turn left into the main parking lot, which is at the south end of the school. The soccer field is at the rear of the school.

**Westbound, towards Pittsburgh, on I-376 (Parkway East)**

Exit the Parkway East at the Churchill Exit, this is a left lane exit. Stay in the left lane and turn left at the first traffic light onto Beulah Road. Proceed about 100 yards to the next traffic light and turn left onto Churchill Road. Stay on Churchill Road for about 1 1/2 miles; go past Edgewood Country Club, until you see Wilkins Elementary School on the left. Turn left into the main parking lot, which is at the south end of the school. The soccer field is at the rear of the school.

### **Track**

In the 4 x 400 meter: the girls team of Katherine Repasky, Grace Bond, Elliot Keverline, and Seava Cresta took first with a time of 5:03.

The 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade girls finished third place overall with 62 points; a mere 9 points behind second and 19 behind first. Congratulations girls and to all of the runners who participated this year.
